Master of Fine Arts Degree and Post-Baccalaureate Certificate Application Information

DEADLINES Master of Fine Arts Degree **February 1 priority deadline, rolling decision afterward**
Post-Baccalaureate Certificate **March 15 priority deadline, rolling decision afterward**

PREREQUISITES Post-Baccalaureate: Applicants must have an undergraduate degree, such as a BA or BFA, from an accredited institution of higher education.

Applicants to the Post-Baccalaureate Certificate program are expected to have had some art training or practice, general educational advancement, and/or professional experience.

MFA: Applicants must have an undergraduate degree, such as a BA or BFA, from an accredited institution of higher education.

History of Art: Students must have a minimum of four one-semester courses in the history of art at the undergraduate level. Those who enter with fewer than four undergraduate art history courses must make up that deficiency during their MFA studies.

Studio Art: Candidates must have a portfolio that demonstrates artistic maturity and readiness for graduate work.

The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is not required for the MFA Program.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

- 1 The enclosed Admissions Application and \$75 fee. Please make check payable to the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston.
- 2 Essay: The essay must be typewritten and a maximum of three pages. See application for essay questions.
- 3 Three letters of recommendation: There is no specific form to be used for recommendations. Recommendations must be received in a sealed envelope.
- 4 Résumé or chronological outline of your background in the arts.
- 5 Transcripts: One official copy of all undergraduate transcripts and one official copy of any other pertinent transcripts, including all prior graduate-level study.
- 6 Portfolio: See strict specifications below. Please note: Portfolios will not be returned.
- 7 Portfolio Inventory: Submit with a complete description of each piece: title, date, dimensions, material/medium.
- 8 International applicants must submit official academic records for each year of post-secondary education, as well as official copies of degrees awarded. If official academic records are in a language other than English, applicants must provide a translated copy. Applicants who speak a language other than English as their native language must submit the score report for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) to the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston. Code number: 3794. The MFA Program requires a TOEFL score of 550 on the Paper-based test, or 79 on the Internet-based test

PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS

Please note: Slides are no longer accepted.

Preparing Your Electronic Portfolio (still imagery)

- You may submit a CD or DVD showing 10–15 recent examples of your artwork.
- All images must be submitted as individual JPEGs. Do not send original work.
- All JPEGs file names must list your last name, first name, and then a two-digit number that corresponds with your portfolio inventory list (for example: SmithJohn01.jpg).
- Each image file must be no larger than 2MB and in cross-platform format (both Apple Macintosh and PC compatible).
- Test your disc before sending and include only those files that you wish to be reviewed.

Preparing a Time-Based Portfolio (video, film, animation, performance, and installation work)

- We accept DVDs that are finalized in QuickTime (preferred), MPEG, or Flash files and in cross-platform format (both Apple and PC compatible).
- Titles of the piece(s) and your name must be included in the introduction of your work on the DVD.
- Include a brief description of the DVD, what part you took in it, and when it was created in your portfolio inventory list.
- If a piece is a collaborative work, briefly explain your contribution in your portfolio inventory list.
- Limit time-based presentations to no longer than 10 minutes.

Sending Your Portfolio to SMFA: You may mail your portfolio or drop it off in person with your application. Do not submit portfolio images via email. Please remember to include a portfolio inventory list. Portfolios will not be returned.

INTERVIEWS

Master of Fine Arts: Following the initial evaluation of the complete pool of applicants, finalists will be notified to arrange an interview. Interviews are typically held in March. Notification of finalists for interview dates will be mailed in February. Final admissions decisions are mailed in March.

Post-Baccalaureate: Students may schedule an interview in conjunction with their application. Interviews are optional. To schedule an interview, contact the Admissions Office at 617-369-3626 or 800-643-6078.

FINANCIAL AID

Post-Baccalaureate Certificate: Financial aid is available through SMFA.

Master of Fine Arts Degree: Financial aid is available through both SMFA and Tufts University. You must apply for financial aid separately to the two schools.

SMFA financial aid: submit the following to the SMFA Financial Aid Office:

- 1 SMFA Financial Aid Application
- 2 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). SMFA code: 004667

Tufts University financial aid: Tufts administers federal programs, including Federal Stafford Loans and Federal Work-Study. To apply for aid at Tufts University, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov by January 15. Tufts Federal Code is 002219.

International students must submit the following:

- 1 SMFA Financial Aid Application
- 2 Foreign Student Supplemental Application
- 3 Certification of Finances

International students are not eligible for federal loans or work-study, and therefore cannot apply for Tufts University financial aid.

Contact the Financial Aid Office at SMFA for an application packet. Since funds are limited, it is essential that you complete your application by the priority filing dates.
