

CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

STUDENT ANNUAL EXHIBITION **2010**

The “Student Annual Exhibition” is the largest annual exhibition of student work. Its aim is to present the most current, dynamic and challenging investigations by Museum School students. Submit your strongest work!

All media are welcome: video, text and image arts, sound, sculpture, print and paper, photography, performance, painting, metals, installation, glass, film and animation, drawing, ceramics and everything in between or not definable as of yet.

Eligibility: All SMFA students (including PT and CE)

You may submit up to three works. Only two may be in the same medium.

Submissions will be reviewed and final selection will be made by an outside jury. The same jury will also select recipients of two awards: the **Will and Elena Bernet Award** (for “formal elements of painting, composition and the principles of structural design”) and the **Stella and Sumner Cooper Award** (for work in metal, glass and/or ceramics).

When submitting time-based work, understand that the jury is instructed to view up to five minutes of each submission (please indicate which five minutes).

When submitting performances, you may submit them on a video, as a written description, as live pieces performed in front of the jury or as a combination of these three (understanding that each time based work is allotted five minutes for review). Live performance reviews will be scheduled for Friday, January 29.

Meeting with the curator to plan special event: All participating artists who wish to give an Artist’s Talk and whose performance was selected for the exhibition should attend the planning session on Monday, February 8, 12:30 pm, in the Anderson Auditorium.

Opening Reception with Performances: Thursday, February 11, 5–7 pm

“Student Annual Exhibition”: Thursday, February 11–Wednesday, March 3, 2010

Artists’ Talk and Performances: Monday, February 22, 12:30–2:00 pm

Pick Up (after closing of exhibition): Thursday, March 4 and Friday, March 5, 10 am–4 pm
