Chartwells Dining Service offers an optional meal plan to all new and returning students at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston (SMFA). Chartwells provides Dining Services at Massachusetts College of Art and Design (MassArt), Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (MCPHS) and Wentworth Institute of Technology (WIT), all located within easy walking distance of Museum School facilities. Payment can be made in cash, debit/credit card or through a convenient declining balance account.

Commuter Plan

By signing up for a commuter meal plan, you will **not be subject to the 5% sales tax** added to all cash purchases. Our commuter meal plan consists of declining balance dollars or Dining Points that work exactly like a debit card. Your declining balance plan gives you the flexibility to spend your Dining Points at your own convenience. Because your Dining Points can only be used in our dining locations, you'll know that you always have money and food! There are three different commuter meal plan options to choose from or you can open up a Dining Points account starting at \$25.00.

Other On-Campus Dining Options:

Café des Arts

Café des Arts is an independent, contracted vendor providing healthful and delicious meals in the School's Atrium. The café offers an array of freshly prepared sandwiches and paninis, a daily hot-bar and salad-bar, hot soups, a bevy of beverages and warm cookies each afternoon. The café manager, Ahmed Abdalla, is an alumnus of the School's Master of Fine Arts program and there is always something innovative going on in the kitchen. The café is open only when classes are in session: Monday–Friday for breakfast, lunch and dinner and on Saturdays for breakfast and lunch. The café accepts cash, credit and debit cards.

Museum of Fine Arts, Boston Dining

The MFA has three dining options available to students and offers a 25% discount with student ID:

- **Courtyard Café** is a casual dining experience with plenty of seating for friends and family. Windows overlook the Calderwood Courtyard and outdoor seating in the Courtyard is available when weather permits. It is located on the lower level of the MFA's Linde Family Wing.
- **The Galleria** evokes the feeling of a Parisian sidewalk cafe and offers light, contemporary cuisine featuring freshly made soups, signature salads and decadent desserts. The Galleria is located on the first floor of the MFA's Linde Family Wing.
- **Bravo Restaurant** offers progressive American cuisine with an emphasis on seasonal local ingredients. It's a nice option when parents are visiting or for a special occasion. The weekend brunch has been heralded as a top Boston brunch destination. Reservations are recommended and may be made by calling 617-369-3474. Bravo is located on the Upper Level Galleria of the MFA's Linde Family Wing.
